As we look ahead to 2025, I am thrilled to share the very first edition of the Humane Society of Southern Arizona's **Quarterly Community Impact Report**. These updates, which you'll receive every three months, will spotlight the incredible lifesaving work made possible by your support. While the reverse side of this report is filled with impactful metrics, I want to take this opportunity to focus on the heartwarming stories behind the numbers.

Between October 1 and December 31, 2024, your compassion fueled these remarkable stories:

- Sonia, a cat missing for nine long years, found her way back to her family, thanks to a chance discovery during a trap, neuter, return event. The joy on her family's faces reminded us why we never stop searching.
- Capri, a resilient kitten who lost a leg but gained a new lease on life, captured the hearts of her adopters. Today, she's thriving in her loving home, a testament to the care and compassion she received.
- **During our Home for the Holidays campaign**, 49 pets joined new families, spreading the joy of the season in the best way possible.
- When 37 small dogs came to us from an overcrowded home in Marana, we provided medical
  attention including spay and neuter surgeries, and got them adopted into loving homes.

These stories are just a glimpse of the impact you've made. On the reverse side of this report, you'll see more details about the lives touched this quarter. Together, we reunited 36 lost pets with their families, placed 310 pets with loving foster caregivers, and supported 110 dogs through our training programs. Every day, our volunteer dog walkers ensured that dogs in our care received joy and enrichment — completing over 8,199 walks in just three months!

And thanks to your unwavering support, we not only met but exceeded our year-end triple-match fundraising goal. Your compassion ensures that we can continue this lifesaving work throughout 2025.
