

VACCINATION SCHEDULE FOR CANINES AND FELINES

Updated April 23, 2026

Be sure to keep all vaccination records together in a safe place, and remember to bring them with you on each visit.

8 weeks to 5 months old

Puppies

Require 4 visits (3-4 weeks apart). These visits include:

- **4 DAPP**—prevents 4 canine viruses—Distemper, Adenovirus, Parvo, and Parainfluenza
- **1 Bordetella**—Kennel Cough
- **2 Deworming**
- **1 Rabies**—at 3 months, valid for 1 year

Kittens

Require 4 visits (3-4 weeks apart). These visits include:

- **4 FRCP**—prevents 3 feline viruses—Feline Rhinotracheitis, Calici, Panleukopenia
- **2 Deworming**
- **1 Rabies**—at 3 months, valid for 1 year

Spay or neuter puppies and kittens at 3 months/3 pounds.

5 months to 12 months old

Dogs

Require 2-3 visits (3-4 weeks apart). These visits include:

- **2-3 DAPP**—Booster
- **1 Bordetella**—Kennel Cough
- **1 Rabies**—Booster

Cats

Require 2-3 visits (3-4 weeks apart). These visits include:

- **2-3 FRCP**—Booster
- **1 Rabies**—Booster

Recommended, but optional. Fees may apply.

- **Heartworm/Tick Fever Testing**
- **Leptospirosis**
- **FIV/FELV Testing**
- **FELV Vaccination**

12 months and older

Dogs

Require 2 visits (3-4 weeks apart). These visits include:

- **2 DAPP**—Booster
- **1 Bordetella**—Kennel Cough
- **1 Rabies**—Booster

Cats

Require 2 visits (3-4 weeks apart). These visits include:

- **2 FRCP**—Booster
- **1 Rabies**—Booster

Yearly booster vaccinations

- **DAPP**
- **Bordetella**
- **Rabies**
- **FRCP**
- **Rabies**
